In Canada, we divide the Narcotic and Psychotropic Drugs in the 3 following Regulations;

1. Targeted Substances as per the *Benzodiazepines and Other Targeted Substances Regulations* (<http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-2000-217/index.html>) maximum of 90 days supply as per section 68 of the Regulations.
2. *Narcotic Control Regulations* (<http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/C.R.C., c. 1041/index.html>) , maximum supply of 30 days
3. Controlled drugs as per Part.G of the *Food and Drug Regulations* (<http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/C.R.C., c. 870/page-138.html#h-325>) Maximum supply of 30 days

Since there are no provisions in the last 2 regulations for travellers, Health Canada has issued a Class Exemption for Travellers who are importing or exporting a narcotic or controlled drug for personal use. (<http://www.hc-sc.gc.ca/hc-ps/substancontrol/pol/pol-docs/travellers-voyageurs-eng.php>)

For prohibited substances: This exemption does not apply to products containing substances listed below, unless they have been approved by Health Canada for market in Canada under the FDR or approved for market in the country from which the product is being imported by the corresponding regulatory authority of that country.
