According to the Medicinal Products Act *a natural person arriving in or departing from Estonia may carry with him or her medicinal products for his or her personal medical use or for medical use on animals accompanying him or her.*

Regulation No. 28 of 9 April 1998 of the Minister of Social Affairs "Procedure for import and export of medicinal products" enacts quantity limits to the medicine passengers can take along:

p.8. Any natural person arriving in or leaving Estonia can take along medicines she/he is going to use for personal medical treatment purposes. Among them one can have psychotropics for two-week's course of treatment and narcotics for a week's course of treatment in the needed amount without the permit of the State Agency of Medicines, along with the medicines the person has to have the copy of the prescription or a note from the medical doctor about the need for the medicines. The amount of the medicines which one has taken with him can not exceed the needs of one course of treatment without the permit of the State Agency of Medicines (to the limit of five retail packages) and the number of different preparations is up to five variant denominations.
