The Permanent Mission of Turkey to the Office of the United Nations and other International Organizations in Vienna presents its compliments to the International Narcotics Control Board and with reference to the latter's letter no.E/INCB/PSY/C.L.23/2004 dated 29 September 2004, has the honor to inform the Board that the travellers under medical treatment carrying medical preparations containing controlled substances for personal use are required to submit the Doctor's report on their treatment as well as the prescription, when entering Turkey. The patients are also expected to carry with them only the amount of medicine necessary to cover the duration of stay in Turkey. Any kind of medicine to be imported by post (for personal use) requires the approval of the Turkish Ministry of Health. The competent Turkish authorities have informed of no special requirements for the departure of such travellers.

The Permanent Mission of Turkey to the Office of the United Nations and other International Organizations in Vienna avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the International Narcotics Control Board the assurances of its highest consideration.
