Swissmedic – Narcotics Division

Strong need for an efficient process in line with the conventions

- In charge of: Narcotics, Psychotropics and Precursors
- 8 staff members (5.9 full time equivalents)
- Strong chemical and pharmaceutical industry:
 - 7500 to 8000 Import and Export authorizations / year
 - Processing time for new requests is at the most 10 working days
- Electronic systems used:
 - NDS, NDS-WEB, NDS-SPA
 - I2ES
 - PEN online
 - MESA (national trade)



Motivation for Switzerland to use I2ES

Electronic exchange of information with I2ES, why?

- More efficient
- Improvement of of Import / Export process
- Increasing need to use IT technology
- Need for verification of import authorizations

Current options to use I2ES

- Manual use: could be used as basic system
- XML upload of data (option to generate XML in NDS)
- Automatic exchange of data between NDS (local system) and I2ES





XML-generation since April 2015

- Generation of XML files (option available in NDS)
- XML generation for authorizations and endorsements



- Filter functions available
- Option to tick more then one transaction





Experience: XML upload using NDS

- Switzerland used XML upload as an interim solution to get experience for the automatic data exchange
- XML upload works efficient:
 - Batch upload to I2ES possible
 - > Filter functions allow to selecte a period (like one week) and country
- Learning: Substance codes used in national system have to be the same as in I2ES (e.g. Levo-methadone)
- To get data from I2ES, login in I2ES is required, two separate systems
- Import and export authorizations not linked in case of XML upload



Automatic data exchange NDS and I2ES

Goals:

- More efficient process
- Improved Import / Export process

Improvements due to automatic data exchange

- Automatic data exchange between authorities could replace paper
- Approval of export requests is based on I2ES data
- Management of discrepancies in endorsements / confirmation of export is based on individual transactions
- Improved management of Estimates / Assessments



Matching of Export-Auth. with respective IMP


- Criteria for matching
 Country code + Import-Authorization number
- Automatic matching
- Option for manual matching
- Authorizations are flagged according to matching status



Non controlled + precursors + countries not active = flag no match



Export – Approval process of Export request






Export request

- Import authorization data from I2ES to NDS
- Automatic or manual matching EXP with resp. IMP in NDS
- Request in NDS-WEB: flag show to Exporter that paper is not required



Request in NDS 7: flag indicates that data from I2ES are available






Approval process of Export authorizations







Manage discrepancies – counterpart first


- Counterpart information available in national system
- Discrepancy is flagged (quantity, quarter of date)






Manage discrepancies – counterpart second

Discrepancy report transaction based





Data Estimates / Assessments from I2ES on a daily basis






Improvements due to automatic data exchange

- More efficient process
 - Electronic data to replace paper in communication between authorities
- Use of I2ES data for approval of export requests
 - I2ES data are more reliable, less risk to falsify
 - I2ES data contain all mandatory data in a standardised format
- Better management of trade discrepancies
 - Transaction based
 - Realtime information
- Estimate / Assessment on daily basis
