ADMINISTRATOR

The **first person** to register for an administrator account is usually the **head** of your **Competent National Authority** (CNA).

INCB will **send a letter to your CNA to confirm** the registration of the administrator.

CONFIRMATION

Once your **CNA certifies** your registration with a **written** confirmation. INCB will provide you login details to use I2ES.

4 STEP

CREATE USER ACCOUNT

As administrator for your country's account, you can create user accounts for your authority.
